

Fiddlers ReStrung's Spring Hometown Concert Saturday May 11th at 6:30 pm at Saline High School

Fiddlers ReStrung will present their **Spring Hometown Concert** on **Saturday, May 11th, 2013 at 6:30 pm** featuring **Hanneke Cassel. Mike Block and Keith Murphy** as guest performers. The concert will be in the Ewing Performing Arts Center at Saline High School at 1300 Campus Parkway in Saline, Michigan. In addition to the performances by Fiddlers ReStrung and their guest artists, the concert will also include performances by the Saline Sixth Grade and Middle School Fiddle Clubs.

Hanneke Cassel is the 1997 U.S. National Scottish Fiddle Champion, she holds a Bachelors of Music in Violin Performance from Berklee College of Music, and she has performed and taught across North America, Europe, New Zealand, Australia, and China. "Exuberant and rhythmic, somehow both wild and innocent, delivered with captivating melodic clarity and an irresistible playfulness," says the Boston Globe about Hanneke Cassel's playing. Such charismatic fiddling has brought the native Oregonian many honors and awards.

Hanneke tours regularly with Baroque/Celtic group Ensemble Galilei, and has performed with the Cathie Ryan Band, Cherish the Ladies, Alasdair Fraser, and Matt Glaser and the Wayfaring Strangers. She is an active member of Boston-based band Childsplay (featuring 20+ fiddles made by Bob Childs) and co-founder (with Laura Cortese and Lisa Schneckenburger) of Celtic chick band Halali. Hanneke's fiddling has graced the stages of The Boston Hatch Shell (performing with Joey McIntyre of New Kids on the Block), Boston's Symphony Hall (opening for Judy Collins), Mountain Stage, The Plaza Hotel, and the Lincoln Center. She teaches regularly at Alasdair Fraserís Valley of the Moon and Sierra Fiddle Camps, Boston Harbor Fiddle Camp, and the Club Passim School of Music.

Hailed by Yo-Yo Ma as the "ideal musician of the 21st Century", Mike Block is a pioneering multi-genre cellist, composer, and educator living in Boston, MA. Mike's personal projects include the Mike Block Band and the Triborough Trio. A product of the Juilliard School, Mike has performed as a member of Yo-Yo Ma's Silk Road Ensemble, and Mark O'Connor's Appalachia Waltz Trio, which he played in for over three years. Mike has also toured extensively with Darol Anger's Republic of Strings, The Absolute Ensemble, Sirius String Quartet, and The Knights. He has performed on "Late Night with Conan O'Brien", "Regis and Kelly", NPR's "St. Paul Sunday Morning", WNYC's "Soundcheck", WNBC's Chuck Scarborough Show, VH1, The Disney Channel, and the CBS "Early Show".

Mike is a dedicated teacher and clinician and founded the Mike Block String Camp in Vero Beach, Florida, with a goal of empowering students to compose, arrange, learn, and perform music by ear, with instruction in multiple non-classical styles.

Fiddlers ReStrung is a 21-piece string ensemble featured at over 60 performances annually consisting of students at Saline High School. The organization is officially sponsored and supported by Saline Area Schools and Saline Community Education.
